What We Do cont'd

- Meet with the bereaved family to offer prayer, support, and guidance as they plan the wake and funeral arrangements – whether held at the church or another location
- Act as a liaison with other church members to provide meals, clean and prepare the home for visitations.
- Visit the family and friends of the deceased at the wake to offer support and prayer on behalf of the Pastor.
- Conduct funeral services if needed or requested by the bereaved family.
- Serve as a greeter at the wake and funeral services.
- Coordinate the repast.
- Provide a support system that can give the bereaved family with ongoing care and ministry throughout the grief cycle.
